



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama was under imminent threat of danger from ice, snow, sleet, freezing rain, as well as subfreezing temperatures, and I, Robert Bentley, Governor of the State of Alabama, did declare a State of Emergency, pursuant to Code of Alabama § 31-9-8 (1975 as amended), in the State of Alabama in anticipation thereof; and

WHEREAS, at the request of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency and after consultation with other affected parties and entities, it has been determined that a State of Emergency no longer exists in the State of Alabama.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert Bentley, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby acknowledge that the State of Emergency issued effective as of 12:00 a.m. CST on Thursday, March 5, 2015, as amended on March 5, 2015, shall hereby be terminated effective as of 6:00 p.m. CST on Friday, March 6, 2015.

FURTHER, I hereby declare that the waiver issued effective as of 12:00 a.m. CST on Thursday, March 5, 2015, pursuant to 49 CFR 390.23 to facilitate a waiver to the U.S. Department of Transportation – Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, including, but not limited to, 49 CFR Section 395 (Hours of Service for Drivers) as it relates to providing emergency or disaster related materials, supplies, goods and services, including, but not limited to, the poultry industry, is hereby terminated.

BE IT ORDERED that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations unless such agency is assisting the affected citizens and communities.
